

AGA Boston Chapter CGFM Scholarship Opportunity

Chapter Year 2010- 2011

Since its inception in 1994, the Certified Government Financial Management (CGFM) has become the standard by which government financial management professionals are measured. To assist our members in obtaining this notable designation, the Boston Chapter of the AGA will be awarding five scholarships to cover the costs of all three parts of the CGFM certification examination including the application fee if the participant passes on the first attempt. The total monetary value of the scholarship is over \$400.

How it works?

STEP 1

- Pass any of the three parts on the first attempt and receive full reimbursement for application and testing fee.
- Provide testing results to the Boston CGFM Director
- Forward testing receipt and application fee to Boston CGFM Director for reimbursement

STEP 2

• Pass the remainder of the test sections and forward receipt to Boston CGFM Director.

*To qualify for the scholarship, interested candidates must be a member of the Boston Chapter of the AGA.
